

# Sizewell C Notice to Mariners No 12 of 2024

## *Diving Operations*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that diving operations will take place close to the Sizewell B intake and outfall towers starting at slack water on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2024.

### **Diving Operations**


A dive team will be deployed from a 14m blue hulled survey vessel called *WM Proteus*. The vessel will anchor close to the two offshore pillars which mark the water outfall and intake structures (see chartlet overleaf). *WM Proteus* shall exhibit conspicuously a rigid replica of the International code flag “A” not less than one metre in height.

Cleaning and inspection of the structures will take place over five days starting on 18<sup>th</sup> October 2024 in daylight hours only.

Other vessels should maintain an appropriate and safe distance when passing the vessel whilst undertaking diving operations and should pass at the lowest speed to avoid vessel wash effects.

Any relevant broadcast requirements for vessels to ‘Pass With Caution’ and if such a broadcast is requested shall exhibit the international code flags “Romeo Yankee”.

A continuous listening watch will be conducted on VHF Channel 16.




