

# Sizewell C Notice to Mariners No 23 of 2026

## Survey Operations

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That bathymetric survey operations are planned to take place on or around 12<sup>th</sup> May 2026 and take approximately 4 days to complete, weather permitting.

The survey operations will be carried out from the vessel Predator and will involve the use of a multibeam echo sounder (no equipment will be towed).



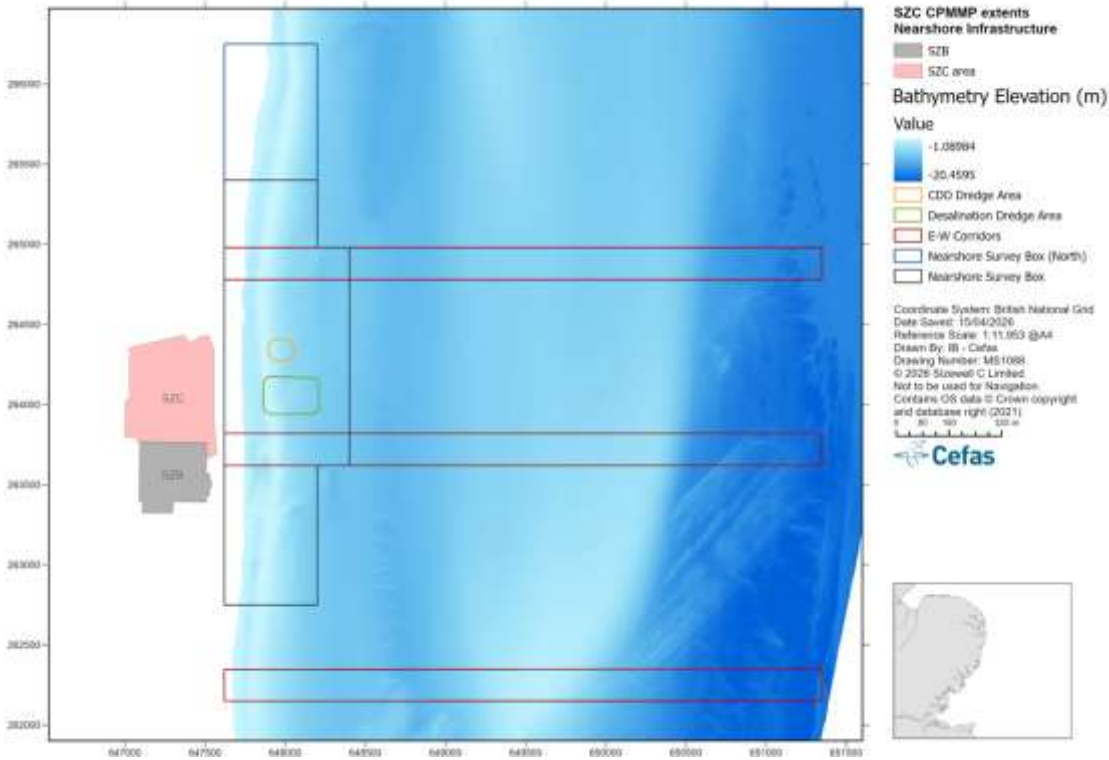
Other vessels should maintain an appropriate and safe distance when passing the vessel while survey operations are underway and should pass at the lowest speed to avoid vessel wash effects. This is particularly important while the vessel is operating very close to the NP497 and to exposed MBIF piles. All vessels should comply with the Colregs at all times. The Predator will maintain a continuous listening watch on VHF Channel 12 & 16.

The survey area will be largely contained within SZC Marine Construction Zone (MCZ) as per the coordinates below, though some operations will be conducted in the wider harbour as shown in the drawing below.
