

Sizewell C Notice to Mariners No 28 of 2026

Survey Operations – Sizewell C Harbour

Mariners are advised that bathymetric survey operations are planned to take place on or around 16th June 2026 and take approximately 4 days to complete, weather permitting.

The survey operations will be carried out from the vessel *Predator* and will involve the use of a multibeam echo sounder (no equipment will be towed). The vessel will be restricted in her ability to manoeuvre and will display the lights and shapes required by the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collision at Sea (COLREGS).



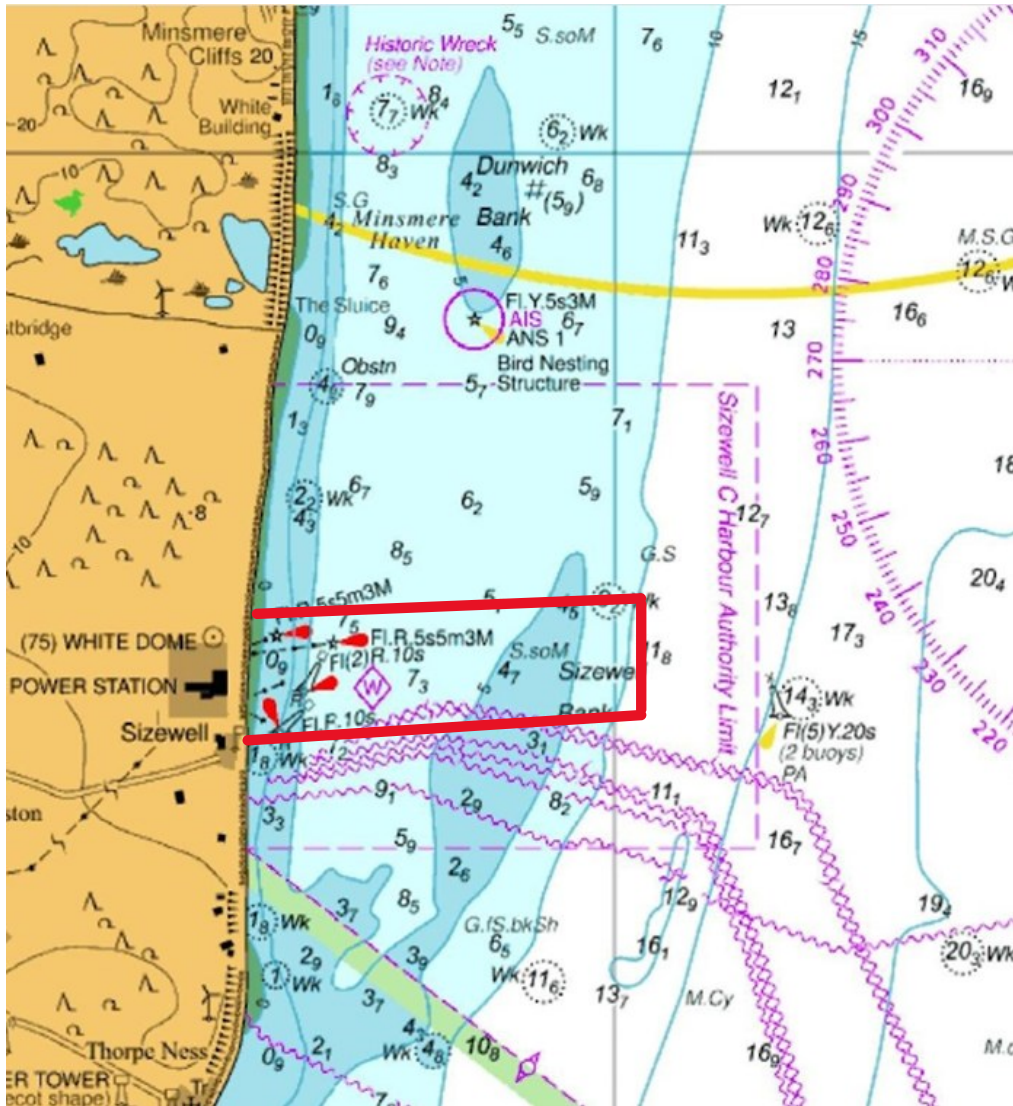
Other vessels should maintain an appropriate and safe distance when passing the vessel while survey operations are underway and should pass at the lowest speed to avoid vessel wash effects. This is particularly important while the vessel is operating close to the SZB structures. All vessels should comply with the Colregs at all times.

The Predator will maintain a continuous listening watch on VHF Channel 12 & 16.

The survey area is outlined in red on the chartlet shown in **Figure 1** overleaf.
