

Sizewell C Notice to Mariners No 31 of 2026

Diving Operations adjacent to Sizewell C Harbour

EA1N & EA2 Windfarm

Diving Operations Mariners are advised that:

On or about the 25th July 2026, diving operations will take place from the vessel **Ocean Supplier** adjacent to the SE corner of Sizewell C Harbour. The vessel will be lying to a five-point mooring located close inshore of the jack-up barge **Haven Seachallenger**, within the exclusion zone detailed in local Notice to Mariners No. 26

Mooring locations:

Mooring 1	52° 10. 97'N	001° 38.59'E
Mooring 2	52° 10. 97'N	001° 38.62'E
Mooring 3	52° 10. 96'N	001° 38.69'E
Mooring 4	52° 10. 87'N	001° 38.62'E
Mooring 5	52° 10. 90'N	001° 38.49'E

Diving operations will take place over slack water periods for approximately four days, weather permitting. All vessels should give the **Ocean Supplier** and **Haven Seachallenger** at least a 500m berth during diving operations throughout this period and pass at as slow a speed as is practicable. The Ocean Supplier will maintain a continuous listening watch on VHF Channel 16 and Channel 12.

Figure 1: EA1N and EA2 Wind Farm Marine Works Location and JUB exclusion zone

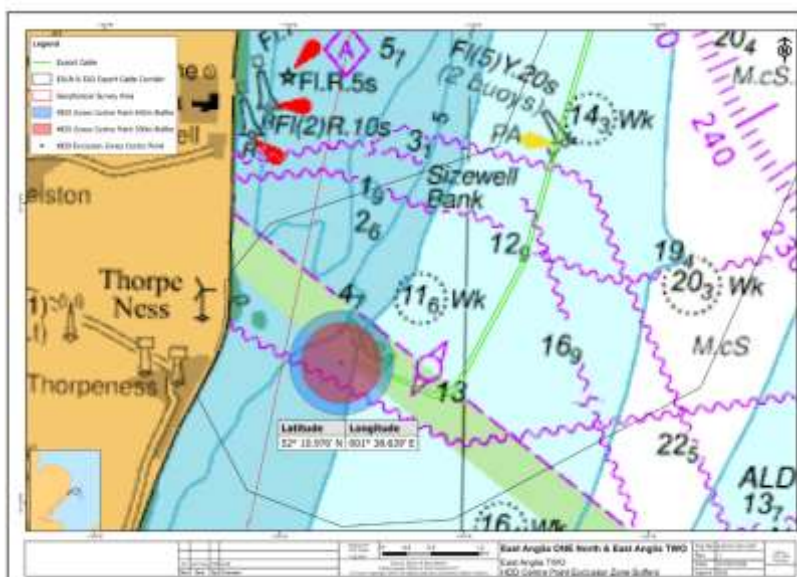




Figure 2; Ocean Supplier
